




My Trip to The WaterShed

Once inside I can hang my coat and backpack if I want to, or I can carry it.




The field trip leader will go over the rules.

We can go into the Snow Theater. It is a dark and small room. I can choose if I want to play in that room.




We might spend time outside on our field trip. We might play outside in the River Campus, or hike to the Boise River or ponds.
